STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

<u>Purpose</u>

This code of conduct exists to give students notice of general conduct which is expected and prohibited. It is not an exhaustive list. Students are accountable for their misconduct. It is a student's responsibility to be familiar with this code of conduct and other behaviour standards required by Numurkah Community Learning Centre Inc. (NCLC).

NCLC Code of Conduct applies to all students and aims to ensure the safety, comfort and well-being of everyone.

It is the responsibility of the Coordinator to ensure that a copy of the student code of conduct is provided to each student on enrolment and signed by the student as an acknowledgement of receipt and understanding.

NCLC aims to ensure that all participants enjoy a congenial time at this venue and recognises the rights of all students to full participation in courses run by NCLC in an undisturbed teaching environment. To support this, the following is expected:

Attendance

 Students are requested to attend a minimum of 80% of classes unless otherwise negotiated between student, teacher and coordinator. If unable to attend, students must endeavour to contact the learning centre prior to class time. When absent for more than 2 days due to illness, a medical certificate must be produced. If continued absences occur without a valid reason, the centre may request a withdrawal from the class.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted in the enclosed premises of NCLC.

Mobile phones

 Mobile phones cause disruptions to classes. NCLC requests that ALL mobile phones be turned off during class time.

Food during class

Unless for prescribed medical reasons, no food should be consumed in class time, except during an
organized activity or break.

Children in classes

- Children are only permitted in classes in exceptional circumstances under prescribed conditions, after consultation with the Tutor. Parents are responsible for making their own childcare arrangements.
- It is not expected that parents would bring their children to classes on a regular basis.

State of classrooms

- Classes run by NCLC are to be conducted in a safe and clean environment. It is therefore important
 that each class takes responsibility for the general tidiness and cleanliness of the classroom and
 equipment:
- It is also the responsibility of each class to arrange the furniture in the allotted classroom to meet their particular needs.

- Requires people who take medication to be aware of medicinal side effects and not to combine it with anything that can place themselves or others at risk.

Breaches of the Student Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action according to NCLC policies and procedures.
