

RPL/CREDIT TRANSFER POLICY

People undertaking accredited training at NCLC Inc are entitled to have their current competencies recognised in order to reduce the time taken to achieve the qualification.

NCLC will provide applicants with support, if necessary, to understand and undertake the RPL/Credit Transfer process. The processes used for offering and assessing.

RPL/Credit Transfer will be consistent with the Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF) requirements.

NCLC will offer RPL/Credit Transfer opportunity to all applicants on enrolment in a structure which is designed to minimise time and cost to the applicant.

NCLC will provide adequate information, support and opportunity for participants to engage in the RPL/Credit Transfer process.

Decisions relating to the granting of RPL/Credit Transfer will rest with the authorised assessor and will be reached after the assessor has conducted an appropriate assessment which can be seen to be authentic, valid, reliable, current and sufficient.

When an applicant is refused credit for a unit, NCLC will advise the person in writing and will provide the reason/s for refusal. The applicant will be given the opportunity to reapply or to appeal the decision.
